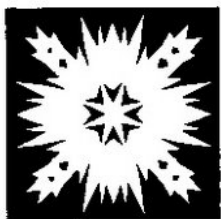

2. Fold it in half.

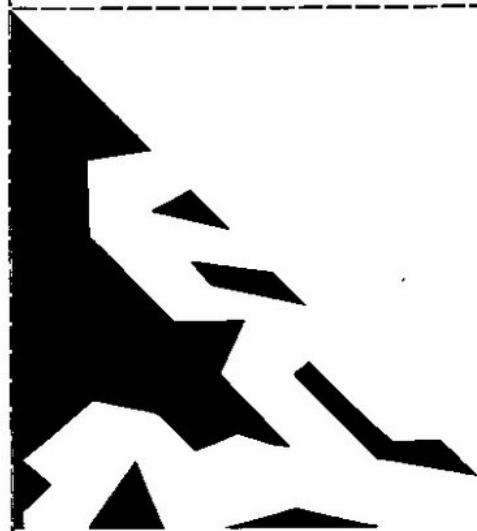
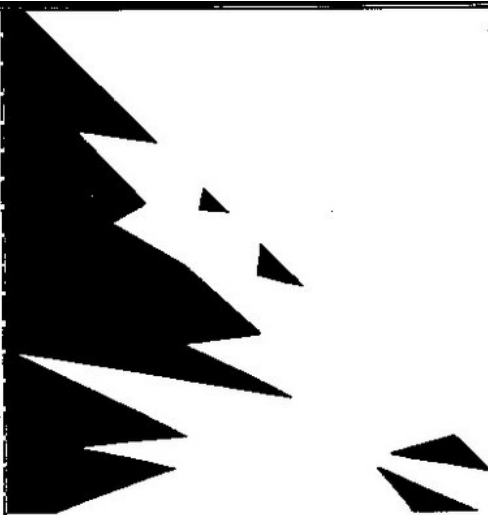


3. Fold it in half again.

2. Fold it in half.



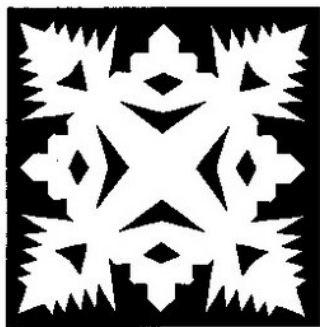

Snowflake Stencil

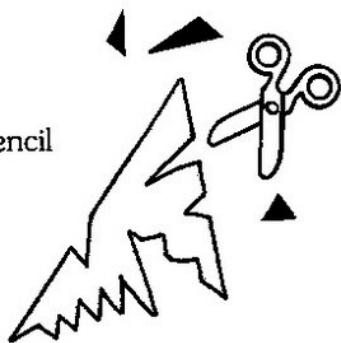
Use this stencil to make as many snowflakes as you want.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

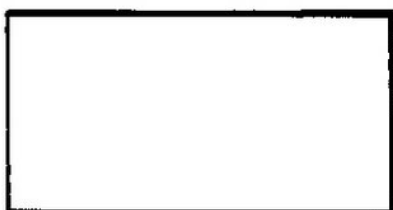
- a pencil
- lightweight paper (8" x 8")
- scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

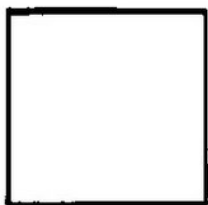
1. Cut out the Snowflake Stencil on the dotted lines. Then cut away all the black areas, so your stencil looks like this.



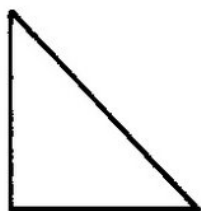
2. Now take a piece of 8" x 8" paper and fold it in half. Press down on the folded edge with your thumb.



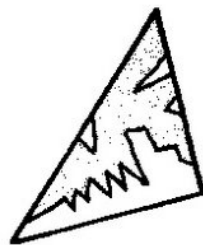
3. Fold the paper in half again. Press down on the folded edges.



4. Now fold it into a triangle. Press down hard on the folded edges.



5. Put the Snowflake Stencil on top of the folded paper, like this.



With a pencil, carefully trace along the edges of the stencil.

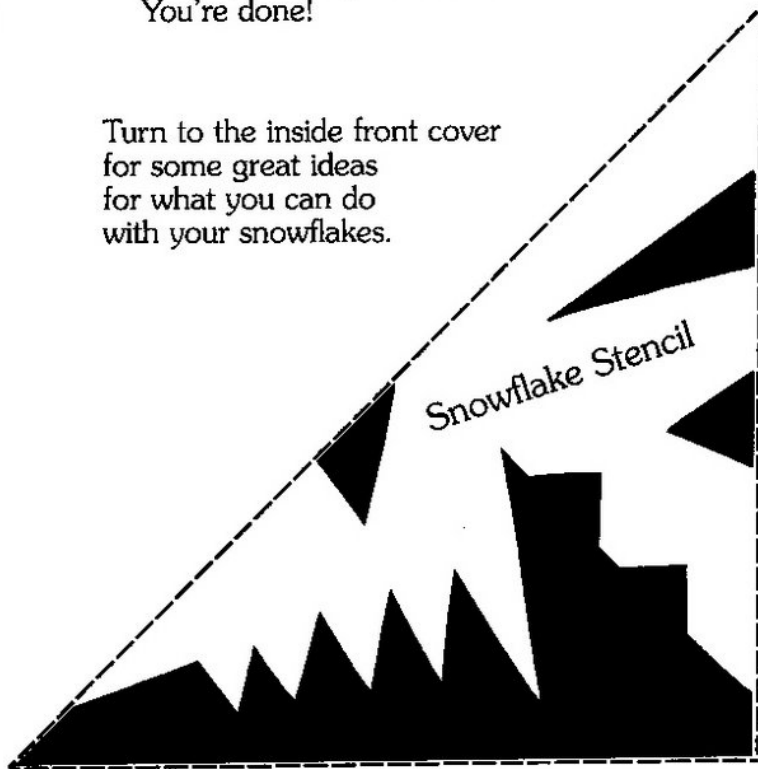


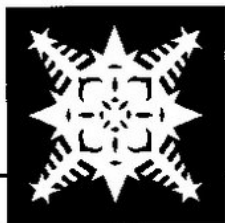
6. Put the stencil aside. Now cut the paper along the pencil lines.



7. Unfold your snowflake one step at a time. Bend each fold in the opposite direction, until the snowflake is completely open and flat. You're done!

Turn to the inside front cover for some great ideas for what you can do with your snowflakes.

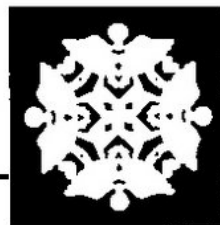

You May Also Want...

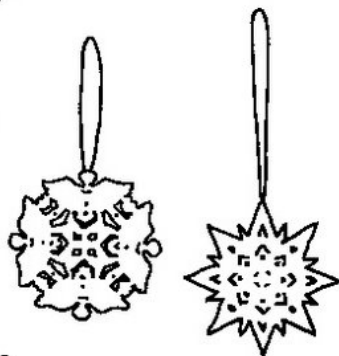
- A glitter pen or colored markers
- Colored paper (for making valentine cards, greeting cards, and mobiles)
- Thread (for making snowflake ornaments, garlands, and mobiles)

What Can You Do With Your Snowflakes?

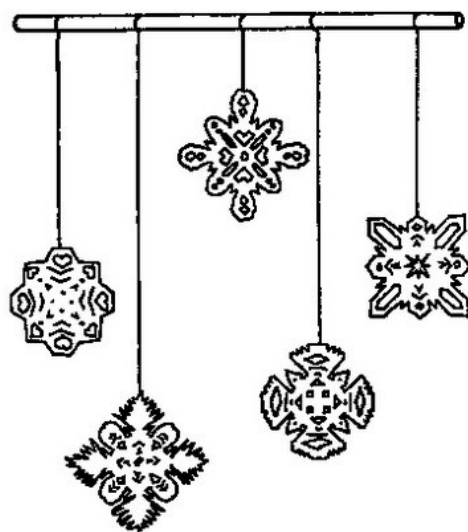
- Decorate them with a glitter pen or colored markers
- Tape them to your window with transparent tape
- Make a garland by taping snowflakes to a long thread



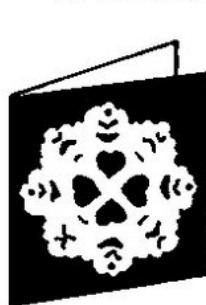
- Tape looped thread to snowflakes and hang them as ornaments



- Decorate presents by taping snowflakes to wrapping paper



- Make a snowflake mobile
- Make valentine cards and greeting cards for all occasions by taping snowflakes to colored paper

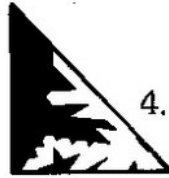

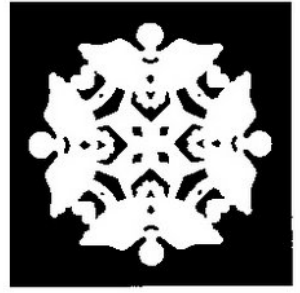

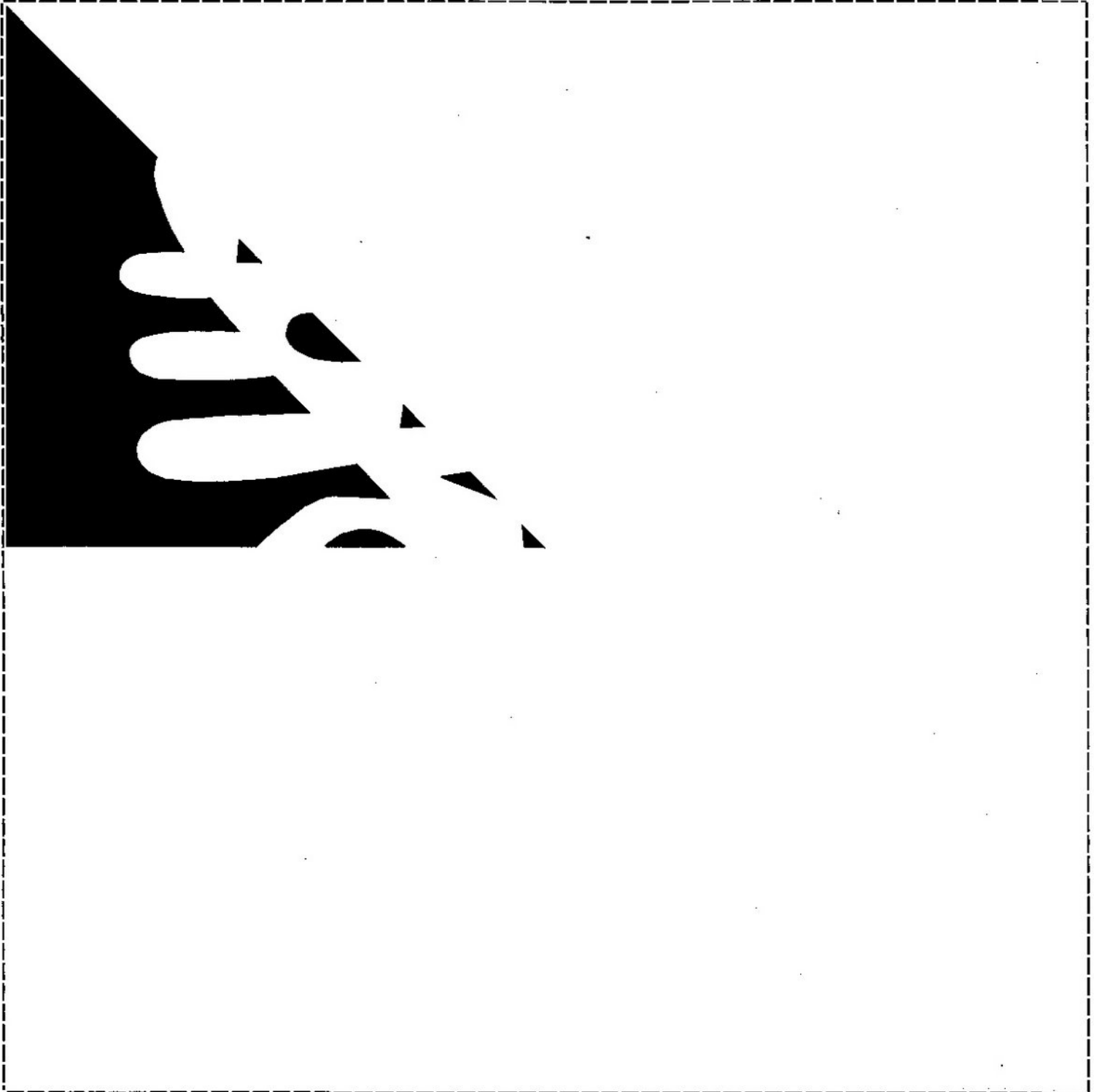

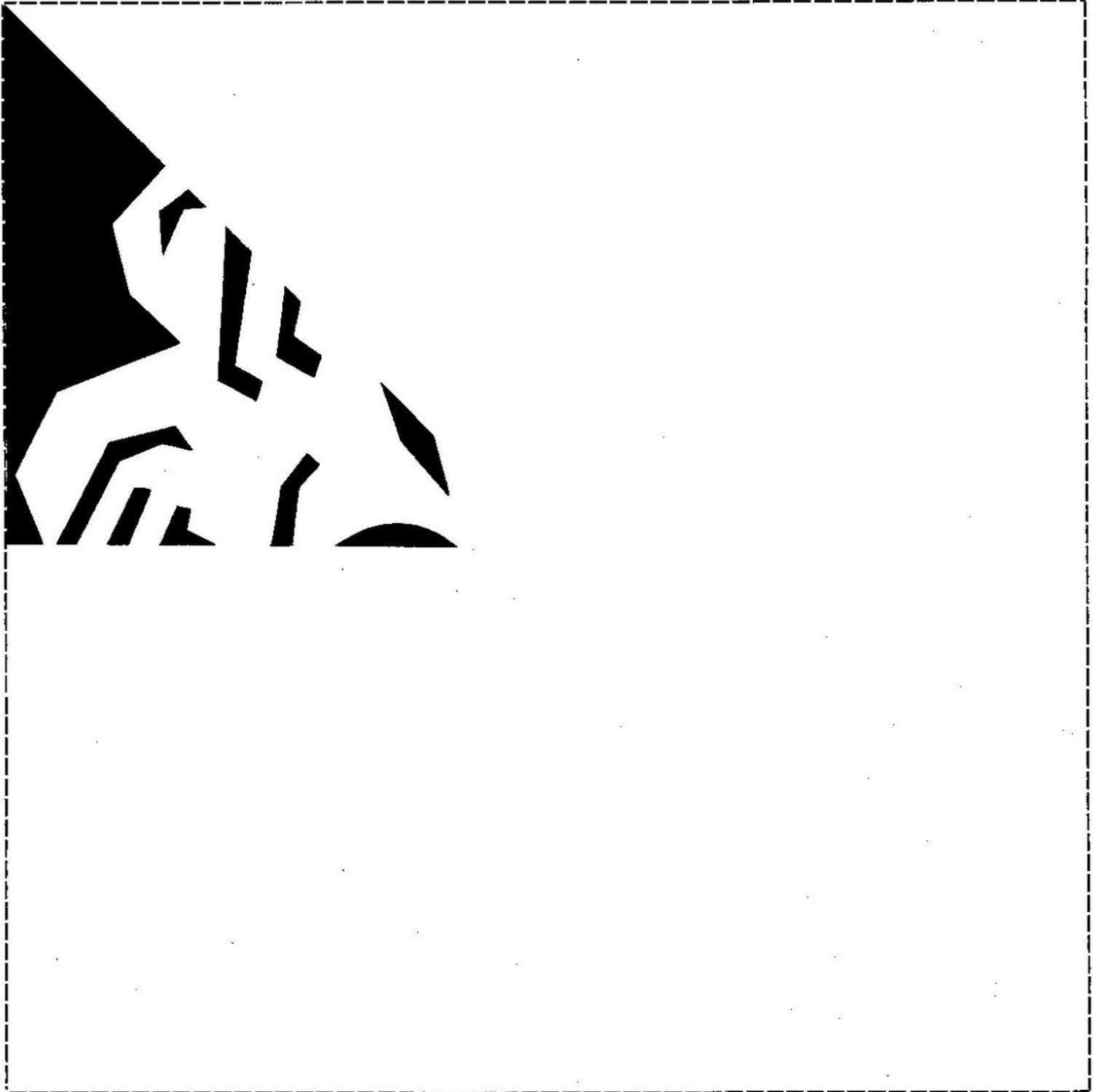

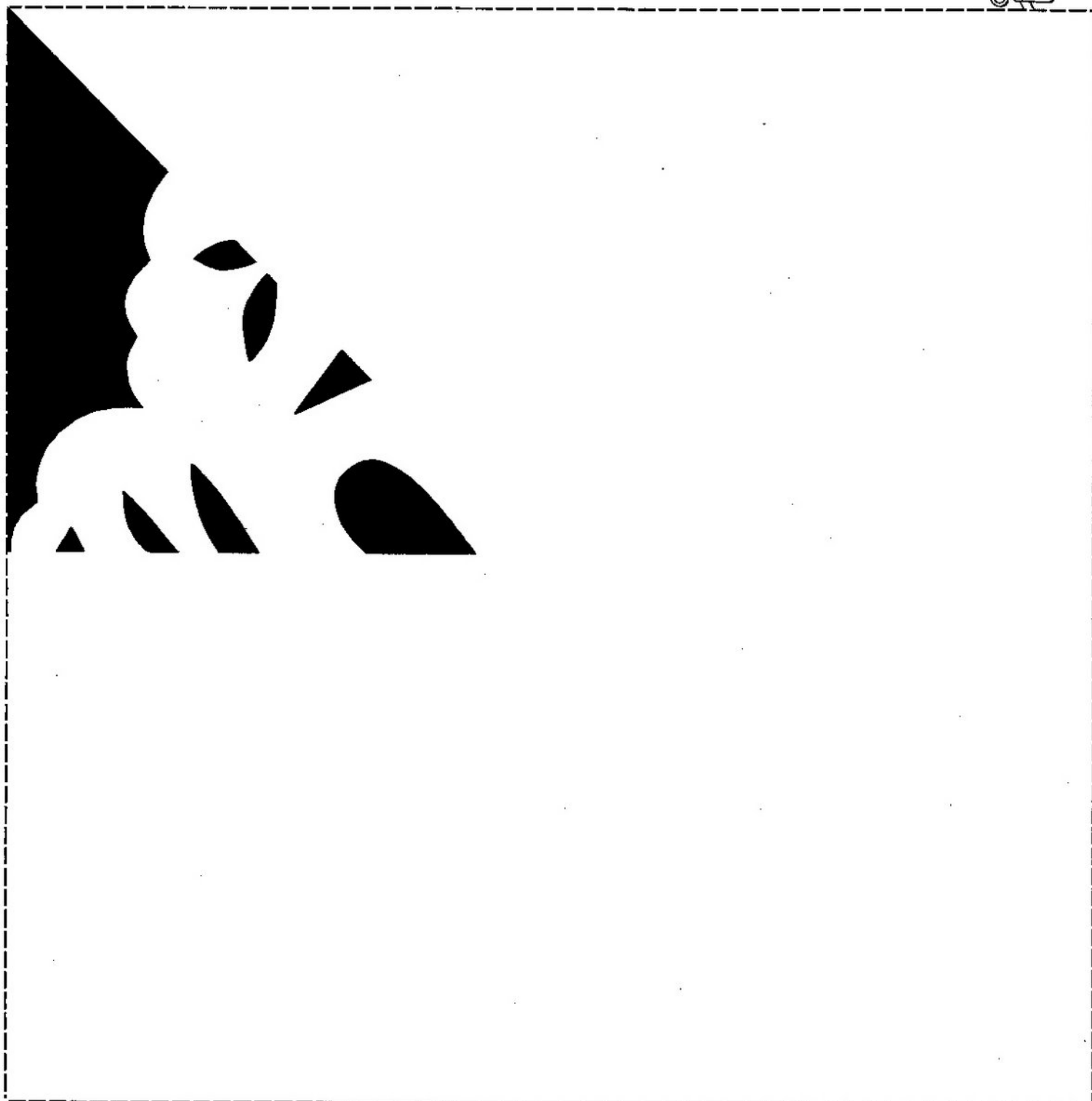

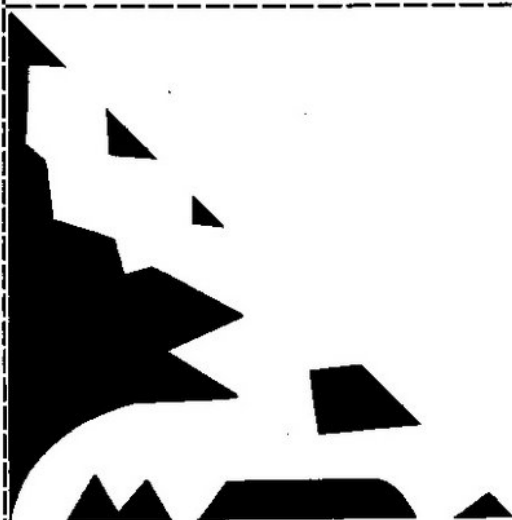

1. Cut out design on dotted lines.



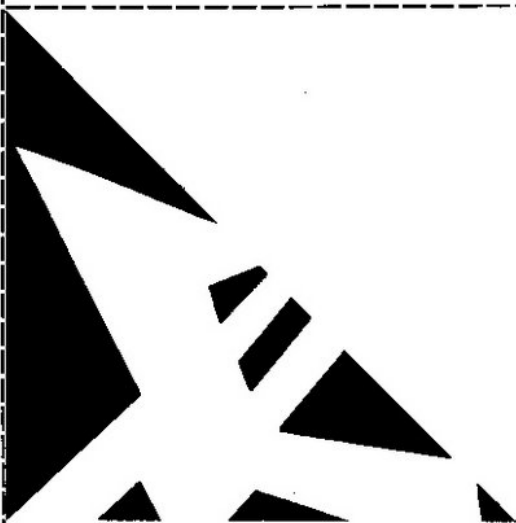
2. Fold it in half.

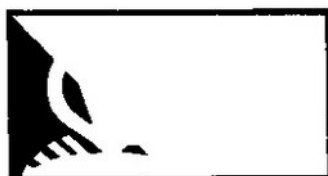
Ice Flower

2. Fold it in half.

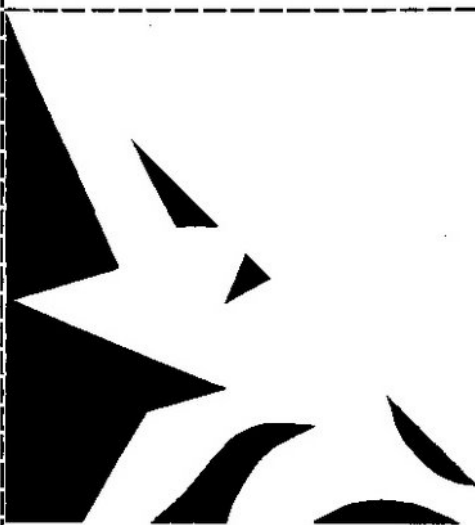


3. Fold it in half again.

3-D Snowflake



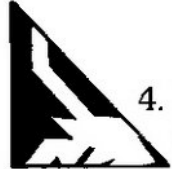
1. Cut out both designs on the dotted lines.



2. Fold one design in half.



3. Fold it in half again.



4. Fold it into a triangle.

5. Carefully cut away the black areas. Now unfold it one step at a time.

6. Repeat the above instructions for the second design.

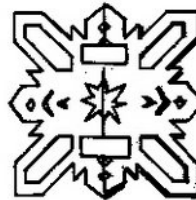
Now tape the two snowflakes together. Here's how:

7. Fold one snowflake in half and lay it on top of the other, like this.

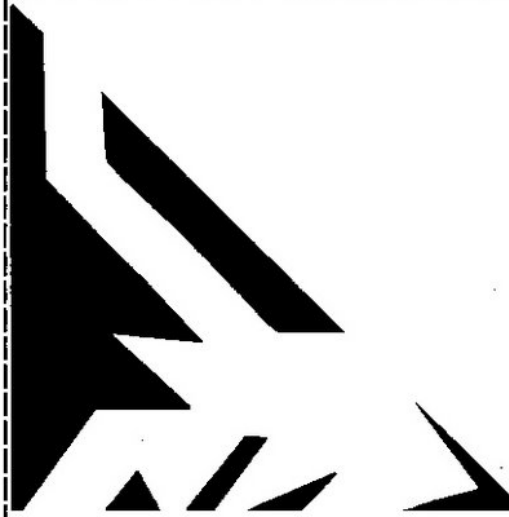
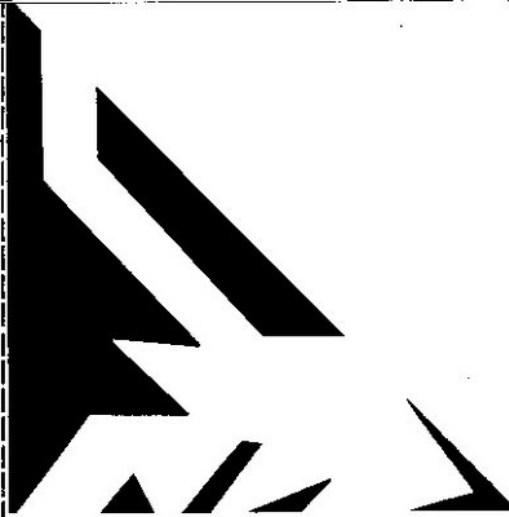
Tape the top snowflake to the bottom snowflake.



Now flip the top snowflake to the opposite side, and tape it to the bottom snowflake.



Adjust the four sides of the 3-D snowflake so that they are the same distance from each other.

into lacy paper snowflakes!
Just cut out and fold each page as shown.
Then snip away the black areas
and unfold —
you have a beautiful snowflake to keep.
Leave your snowflakes plain
or decorate them with a glitter pen
